

## **II Latino-America Investigator on Bipolar Disorders Award**

Asociación Argentina Trastornos del Humor (ASATHU) is accepting proposals for the II Latino-America Investigator on Bipolar Disorders Award. This award constitutes a good example of healthy interaction between pharma industry, academia and investigation. Winners of this award will receive waived registration fees for the IV Iberoamerican Conference on Bipolar Disorders from May 5-6, 2011 in Córdoba, Argentina and will have the opportunity to present their winning proposal in a symposium.

**Eligibility:** Any Latino-American investigator in the field may apply. Previous winners of this award are eligible to apply.

**The Awards:** The awards will consist of:

1<sup>st</sup> place: Full travel, hotel accommodation and-inscription for the 5<sup>th</sup> Biennial Conference of the International Society for Bipolar Disorders\* (ISBD) will be provided.

2<sup>nd</sup> place: Full one year membership in ISBD.

3<sup>rd</sup> place: A volume of the 2<sup>nd</sup> edition (2007) of the *Manic Depressive Illness* by Goodwin and Jamison.

**Selection Process:** A representative committee of ASATHU will select the winning proposals. No employee from Eli Lilly will participate in the selection of the proposals.

**Proposal Requirements:** The topics of the proposal must address basic or clinical aspects of bipolar disorder. The proposal should be based on original work that has not been published elsewhere. The proposal must be written in Spanish or Portuguese and can be submitted as an article of no more than 500 words.

**Deadline for Submissions:** Applications must be received no later than March 31, 2011. Award recipients will be notified of their selection on April 15, 2011.
